Occupational Therapists and a National Social Work Agency

Introduction

The Scottish Government proposes to create a National Social Work Agency (NSWA). This would be set this up within government as a unit within the proposed National Care Service.

Early work on the proposal has been undertaken by the Office of the Chief Social Work Adviser (OCSWA), Social Work Scotland (SWS) and the Scottish Association of Social Workers (SASW). After making representations, UNISON is now represented on the Government's Advisory Group by Stephen Smellie, UNISON's Depute Convenor and Chair of UNISON Scotland's Social Work Issues Group.

The NSWA proposal is looking at national arrangements for social workers and para-professionals (social work assistants, family support workers, etc) working in social work fieldwork teams. These arrangements are envisaged as including education and training, governance, quality assurance & improvement, leadership and culture and workforce matters.

Workforce matters includes looking at national pay and terms and conditions.

When asked whether Occupational Therapists were included in the scope of the proposal, the Chief Social Work Adviser to the Scottish Government advised that they would not be, as they were only considering social workers and para-professionals.

UNISON has pointed out that Occupational Therapists are critical to several areas of fieldwork social work and that any considerations need to include them. This point has been taken "under consideration."

It is disappointing that the officials devising the proposal for a NSWA did not recognise the role of Occupational Therapists in Social Work. However, UNISON will continue to highlight that role.
