

Myth 6

Disability isn't a big issue in my work

FACT: This is not true. Around 40% of the Scottish population has at least one long-term health condition. One in four adults over 16 years have a long-term illness, health problems or disability and one in five people of working age is disabled. (Scottish Government, 2019)

On average, a person's health starts declining from

mid-forties (APS, 2017) and the average age a person becomes disabled is 57-years-old. (Scottish Government, 2018)
