



UNISON Scotland have published For our Public Services. Our manifesto for the general election. In this manifesto we set out the issues that UNISON will expect the political parties to address in the election. Important though it may be - this election cannot just be about Brexit. Public services are central to the quality of life of our citizens. Our manifesto makes clearis made clear that we need a government that will invest in services and give citizens the high quality services they deserve.

#### **WINTER FUEL GRANT**

Members living on a low income constantly struggle to make ends meet – and this can be particularly acute in the winter when the cost of heating homes rises as the outside temperature falls.

But it's not all bad news – help IS available. The union's welfare charity **There for You** has once more set up a limited fund to help members on low incomes towards the cost of their winter fuel bill through a one-off

payment of £40.
